Challenges for FP8

- Lisbon Treaty: development of ERA has become the primary objective of the FP
- Strengthening the coordination activities of Members States to better complement the measures undertaken in the FP
 - ERA-NET, Joint Programming
 - Private Public Partnerships
- Synergies with Structural Funds, CIP and EIT
- Strengthening innovation
- Simplification of procedures



FP to be developed into a central instrument to realize the ERA

- Continuation of the FP7 Specific Programme "Cooperation"

Increase of budget

- Better funding chances for excellent projects
- Additional resources for new initiatives
- Larger budget portions are lost (e.g. for GMES, Recovery Programme, PPP)



Facilitating Innovation and Developing Lead Markets

- Holistic integrated programme of the knowledge triangle
- Addressing the innovation gap
- Integration of the R&D-relevant parts of CIP as well as the EIT
- Demonstration activities
- Funding clusters in the context of EIT, Regions of Knowledge,
 CIP



Strengthening excellence

- Scientific and technological excellence as the priority criterion when selecting projects
- Funding of excellence may not be mixed with cohesion measures
- ERC to be reinforced as the main instrument for excellencedriven basic frontier research

Opening FP to international co-operation

- Coherent development within the frame of SFIC



Increasing the Efficiency

- Continuity of instruments
- Defragmentation: harmonizing the implementation of the sometimes very heterogeneous funding measures and instruments
- Evidence-based monitoring: framework of sustainable implementation plans
- FP to be developed as a "learning programme"
